


Bull Run Watershed & System Map

Bull Run Lake




Bull Run Dam #2

PORTLAND WATER SUPPLY AND ROCKWOOD

- . Water purchased from the City of Portland is the primary source of the District's water supply.
- . Rockwood entered its first contract to purchase water from Portland in 1943 and has done so continuously ever since.
- In 2006 the District and City entered its current 20-year Water Sales Agreement. It expires in 2026 and provides for a guaranteed supply of 7.8 million gallons per day.
- . Portland's sources include the Bull Run and a series of wells along the Columbia south shore. Some of Portland's and Rockwood's wells are in the same aquifer.
