

Cascade Well 7

The City and Rockwood Water People’s Utility District (RWPUD) jointly own and operate the Cascade Well Field and have formed the Cascade Groundwater Alliance (CGA) to expand the local groundwater system to serve customers. Under the CGA, the City of Gresham and RWPUD continue joint development and shared management of the groundwater wells. Cascade Well 7 is one of five groundwater wells developed through this partnership and a key element of the first project completed to expand the groundwater system to ensure customers of the City and RWPUD have a safe, reliable and abundant water supply for their customers.

Cascade Well 7 (New Construction)

710 NE 202nd Avenue

- New groundwater well producing 5.6 million gallons per day
- Standby generator
- Associated site improvements and electrical
- Associated water transmission line

In addition to drilling Cascade Well 7, project 1 includes upgrading one existing reservoir and building one new reservoir.

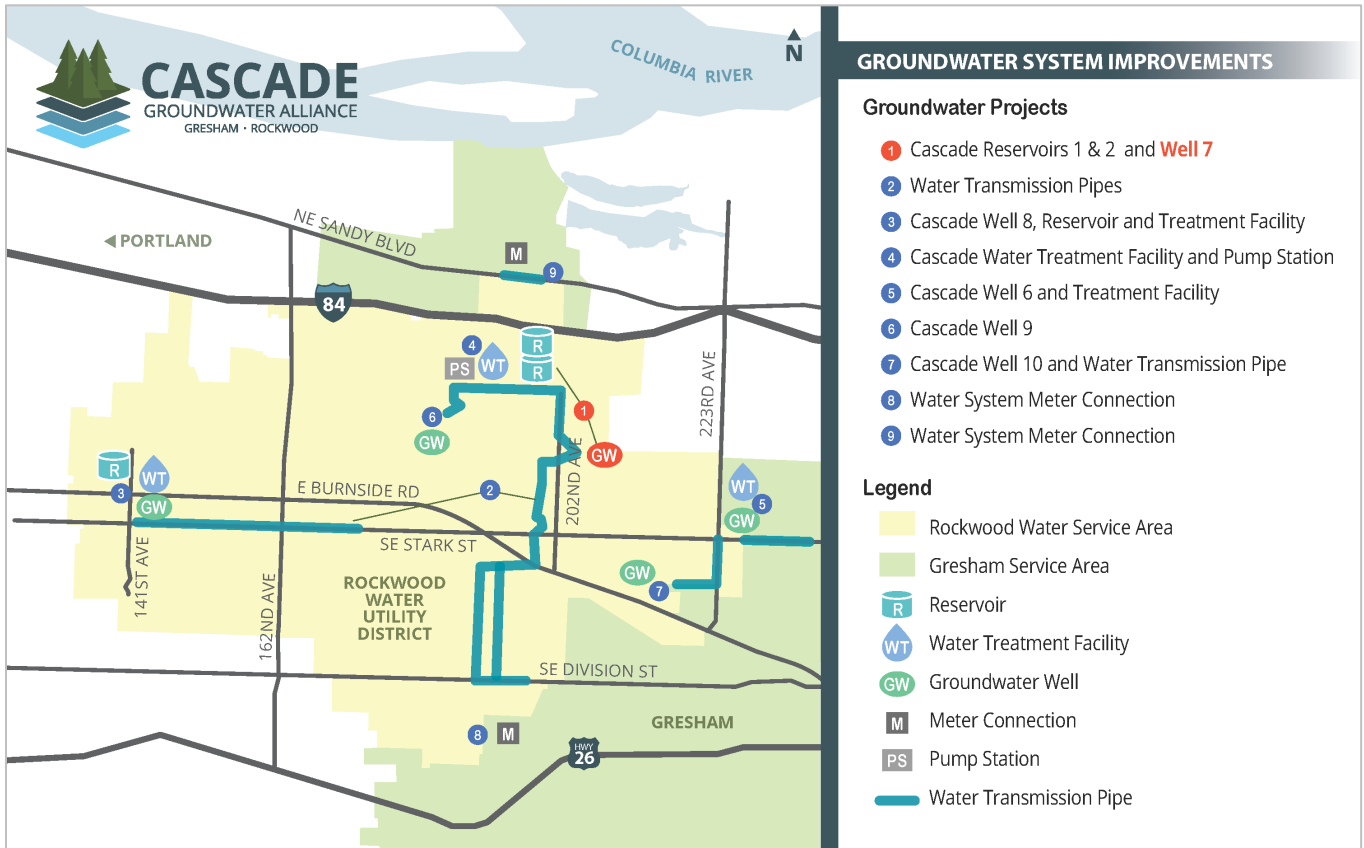


Project Status (Project 1)
