

Cascade Water Treatment Facility and Pump Station

One of the capital improvement projects being built as part of the Cascade Groundwater Alliance (CGA) includes a new water treatment facility and pump station on the Rockwood Water District campus. The CGA is a partnership between Rockwood Water People's Utility District (RWPUD) and the City of Gresham to expand the groundwater system. The new system consists of nine interrelated projects including wells, treatment facilities, reservoirs, well connections, and water transmission pipes.

Expanded capacity for Gresham and RWPUD

The new water treatment plant and pump station will meet state and federal drinking water standards and ensure customers in the Gresham and RWPUD service areas have an abundant supply of drinking water for generations to come.

Project Highlights

- State-of-the-art water treatment facility with capacity for 25-30 million gallons of water per day
- Upgraded pump station to replace the existing pump station
- New storage building to replace the existing storage building
- New backwash tank and a new salt storage tank for the water treatment facility
- Enclosure for the existing Well No. 4
- New vertical turbine to replace the submersible pump/motor for existing Well No. 4
- Piping to connect the water treatment plant, reservoir outlets and new pump station
- Stormwater management facilities, landscaping, and fencing


How the Treatment Process Works
