## WORK TO BE COMPLETED IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

### Project Overview

Rockwood Water People's Utility District (RWPUD) is constructing new Cascade Groundwater Alliance drinking water pipelines to connect to a new reservoir, well and water treatment facility. The Cascade Groundwater Alliance is a partnership between the City of Gresham and RWPUD to build and operate an independent, safe, and reliable water system.

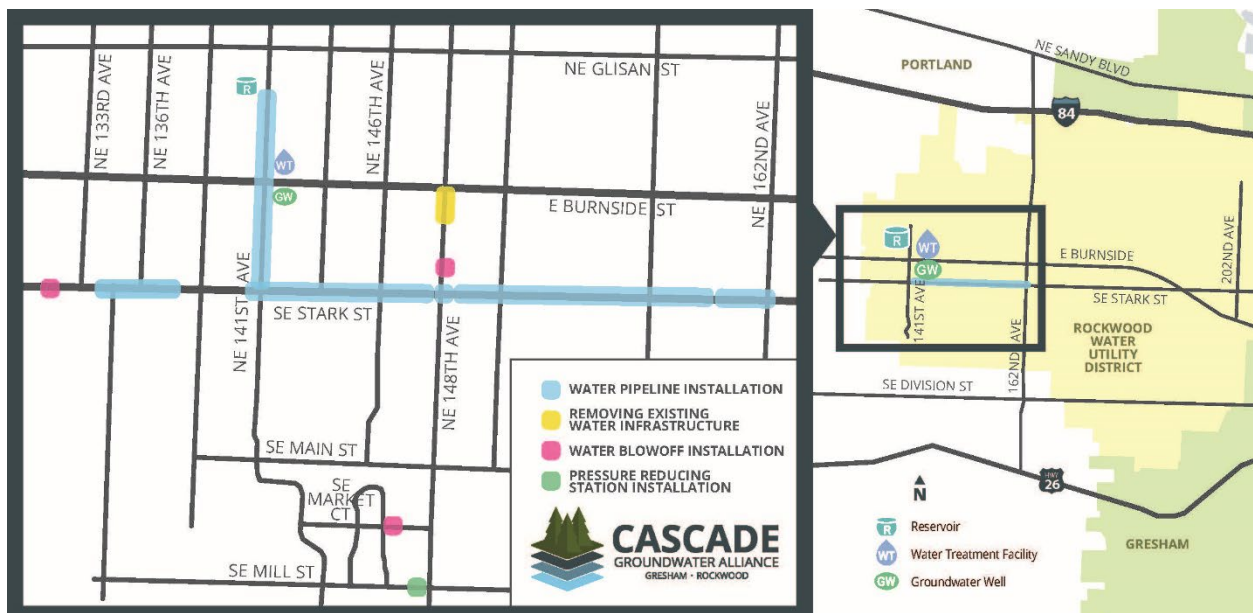
### Project Benefits

The construction area runs along SE Stark St from 162<sup>nd</sup> Ave to 133<sup>rd</sup> Ave and along 141<sup>st</sup> Ave and 148 Ave between NE Glisan St and SE Stark St.

## Project Impacts

- Your neighborhood will experience scheduled water service shutdowns for repairs and final water pipeline connections. You will receive notices in advance of these shutdowns.
- For some customers, we need to disconnect their water line to hook it up to the new water pipeline, which typically takes about 30 minutes. You will receive notices before these water disconnections, and Rockwood Water People's Utility District crews will knock on your door to notify you before disconnecting your service.
- Traffic and parking impacts are expected in the immediate work area, and crews may leave their equipment there overnight. Please adhere to all parking notices.
- Construction will not block driveways.
- Safety cones and signage will be used to control traffic per the approved traffic control plan.

**Schedule:** Mondays-Fridays from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. except holidays.
