



Cascade Groundwater Alliance Transmission Pipeline

Rockwood Water and the City of Gresham created the Cascade Groundwater Alliance (CGA) partnership to build and operate an independent, safe, and reliable water system. Design and construction of the new groundwater system is underway and consists of nine inter-related projects. When complete, the new system will expand our groundwater supply capacity to serve our community with high-quality water for generations to come.



The backbone of the new system is approximately 10 miles of large diameter water transmission pipeline. The new pipeline is being built to modern seismic standards for strength and resiliency. In the event of an earthquake or other disaster, this will limit damage and enable water service to be restored faster so the community can recover more quickly.



Control valves, redundant interties, and other operational equipment will also be installed along the pipeline route to allow for long-term pipeline maintenance and operations.

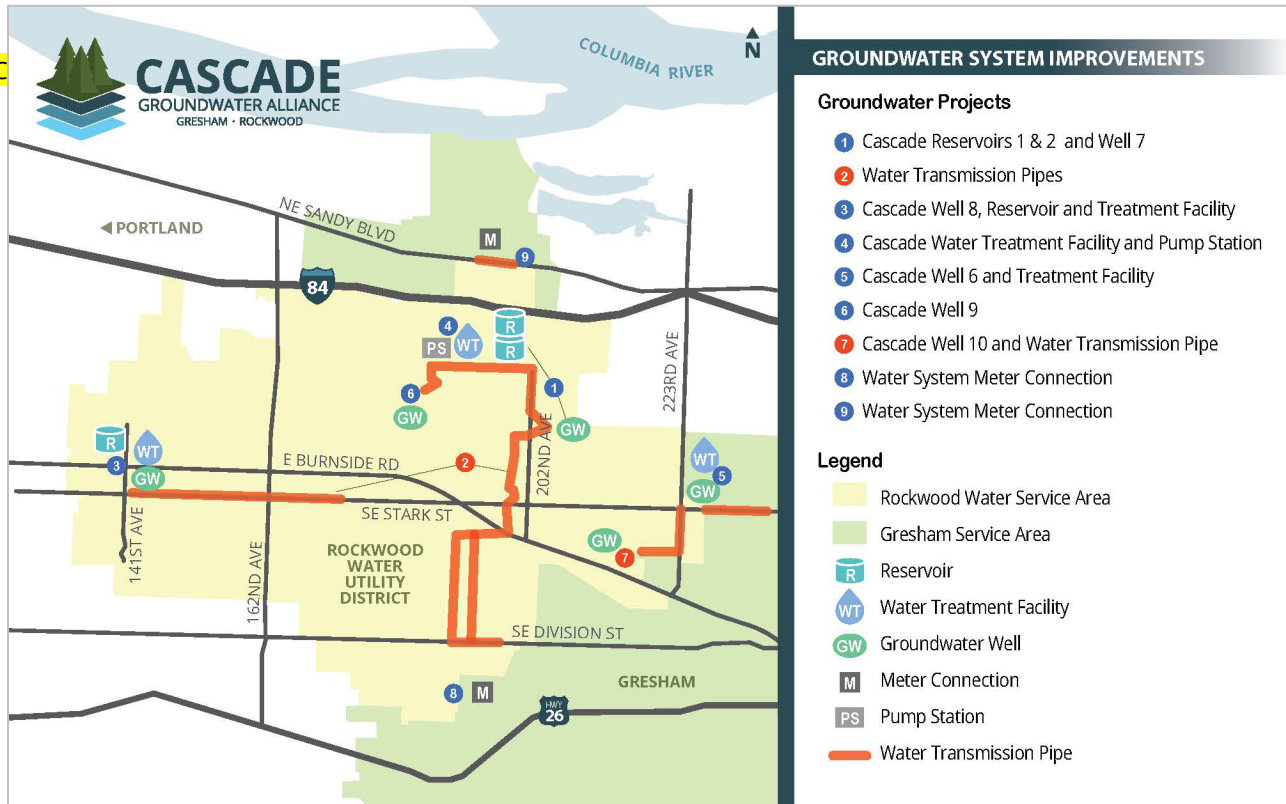
Pipeline Project Anticipated Schedule*
